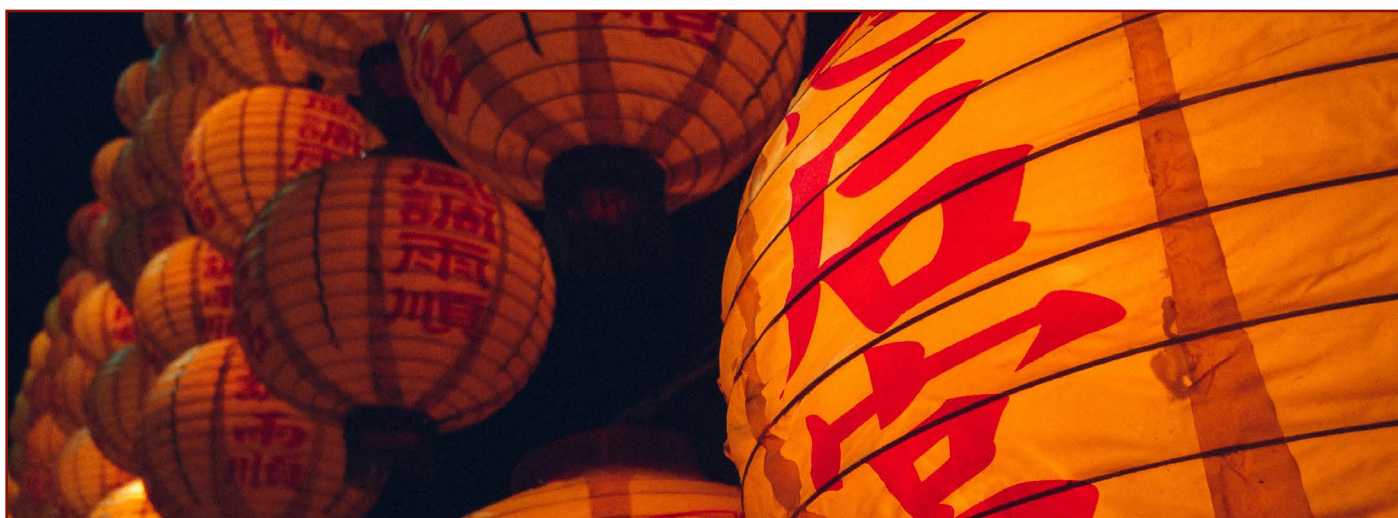

TAG-Confucius Institute Participates in the Second International Cultural Day at Jadara University

TAG-Confucius Institute Organizes Semi-Final of the 25th Chinese Bridge-Chinese Proficiency Competition for Foreign College Students in Jordan



On May 21, the semi-final of the 25th Chinese Bridge-Chinese Proficiency Competition for Foreign College Students in Jordan and the 17th “The Great Wall–Petra Cup” Chinese Proficiency Competition for Jordanian College Students was successfully held. The event was jointly hosted by Center for Language Education and Cooperation of the Ministry of Education of China and the Chinese Embassy in Jordan, and organized by Amman TAG-Confucius Institute. A total of 27 contestants from TAG-Confucius Institute (TAG-CI), the University of Jordan (UJ), Confucius Institute at Philadelphia University (CIPU), Al-Ahliyya Amman University (AAU), and Applied Science Private University (ASU) competed on the same stage.



Among the distinguished guests attending the event were Mr. Zhao Xiaoqiang, Cultural Counsellor of the Chinese Embassy in Jordan and Director of the China Cultural Center in Amman, Ms. Zhuang Ziyue, Secretary of the Cultural Office of the Chinese Embassy; Mr. Mamoun Abu Al-Sebaa, Jordanian Director of TAG-CI, Dr. Yang Songfang, Chinese Director of TAG-CI, Ms. Randa Al-Yabroudi, Deputy Director of TAG-CI; Dr. Yousef Khataybeh, Head of Chinese Teaching at UJ; Dr. Dima Al-Malahmeh, Jordanian Director of CIPU, Dr. Ding Haibin, Chinese Director of CIPU; Dr. Renata Al-Asali, Head of Language Department at AAU; Dr. Haifaa Aldabbagh, Head of Chinese Teaching at ASU; as well as teachers, students, and Chinese language enthusiasts from various institutions. More than 120 people attended the event.



The theme of this year's competition was "One World, One Family." The semi-final consisted of a themed speech and a quiz covering the Chinese language, Chinese culture, and China's national conditions. A panel of seven judges, composed of the Chinese embassy officials and Chinese language teachers, evaluated the contestants. During the speech session, contestants focused closely on the theme "One World, One Family." Drawing on their experiences learning Chinese, participating in exchange programs in China, and their understanding of cultural exchanges between China and Arab countries, they shared in fluent and sincere Chinese their reflections on world

harmony, peace, and the concept of a global community with a shared future for mankind. The contestants spoke naturally and confidently, fully demonstrating their strong Chinese language proficiency. In the quiz session, faced with challenging questions, the contestants remained calm and answered actively, showcasing impressive learning outcomes and a deep love for Chinese culture. Their performances reflected the enthusiasm and vitality of Jordanian youth in learning Chinese and understanding China.

After fierce competition, a total of 10 outstanding contestants advanced to the final round, including five contestants from TAG-CI, three from UJ, and two from CIPU. The competition not only provided a platform for Jordanian university students to showcase their Chinese language proficiency and exchange learning experiences, but also contributed to the further development of Chinese language education and the promotion of Chinese culture in Jordan.

The finalists will compete in the final round on June 3, further demonstrating the vitality and aspirations of youth and contributing to a new chapter in China-Jordan cultural exchanges and China-Arab civilizational exchange and mutual learning.

China

China, officially the People's Republic of China (PRC), is a country in East Asia. It is the second-most populous country after India, with a population exceeding 1.4 billion (17% of the world's population), across an area of 9.6 million square kilometers (3,700,000 sq mi), making it the third-largest country by area.

It is divided into 33 province-level divisions, including two special administrative regions. Beijing is the capital, while Shanghai is the most populous city by urban area. Its geography features the vast Central Plain, major rivers such as the Yangtze and Yellow River, deserts, subtropical and temperate forests, and mountain ranges such as the Himalayas.

The first humans in China arrived during the Paleolithic. By the 2nd millennium BCE, dynastic states had emerged. The 1st millennium BCE saw political turmoil and cultural growth. In 221 BCE, China was unified under the Qin and the succeeding Han dynasty, ushering in two millennia of imperial rule across periods of unity and division. Its achievements include widespread cultural influence, the Silk Road, and the invention of gunpowder, paper, printing, and the compass. After increased Western political, economic, and philosophical influence, the 1911 Revolution overthrew the empire and established the Republic of China (ROC). The Warlord Era and Chinese Civil War followed, interrupted by Japan's invasion. This ended in a Chinese victory in 1945. In 1949, the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) proclaimed the People's Republic of China and forced the ROC's retreat to Taiwan. Both sides claim political legitimacy. CCP attempts to advance communism faltered through famine and

political turmoil. The reform and opening up that began in 1978 moved China towards a market economy, spurring economic growth.

The PRC is a unitary communist state with the CCP as its sole ruling party. It is one of the five permanent members of the UN Security Council and a member of many multilateral organizations. China is the world's largest manufacturer and makes up about one-fifth of the global economy.

It is the second largest economy on Earth. International organizations rank China poorly in measures of democracy and human rights. Since the 2020s, it has been described as a superpower due to its large military, nuclear stockpile, and influence in geopolitics, science and technology, manufacturing, economics and culture.

Chinese art and culture has influenced much of Asia. Chinese characters are among the oldest writing systems on Earth, with a literary tradition dating back millennia to the Chinese classics. China is the birthplace of Confucianism and Daoism, which form the traditional three teachings of Chinese philosophy and folk religion alongside Buddhism. Chinese cuisine is diverse and highly regional, with rice as a staple in the south and wheat in the north. It has over 60 World Heritage Sites, including the Great Wall and Grand Canal. The Han, mostly speakers of Sinitic languages, are China's dominant ethnicity, although it is home to 55 recognized minorities, including the Hui, Mongols, Tibetans, Uyghurs, and Zhuang.
